Madron Parish Council is considering doing a Neighbourhood Development Plan for Madron in order to ensure that the community can shape the future development of our area.

This is a real opportunity to have an active say in the future of Madron Parish and we would like to know what you think.

What is a Neighbourhood Development Plan?

Neighbourhood Development Plans (NDP) can set out local level planning policies for that area, shaping future development.

Under the Localism Act 2011, Parish and Town Councils can write an NDP for their area with their community.

Subject to conforming to national policies, the Cornwall Local Plan strategic policies, an independent examination and gaining support through a referendum of residents, this plan will be adopted as a formal planning policy by Cornwall Council. This means that planning decisions in Madron Parish will have to be made in accordance with the NDP.
