

**NOTES OF A MEETING OF THE
Madron Parish Council Neighbourhood Planning
Communications and Engagement Strategy Working Group 10th October 2019**

1. Meeting held at Peter's house. Present were Graham, Simon, Peter, Steve and Geoff.
2. The format of the forthcoming first community survey form was agreed to be:
 - a. A4 folded down to A5
 - b. Topic priorities to be responded to in order of precedence 1 to 15
 - c. Same form for both adults and for use in local schools.
3. A Neighbourhood Plan Project logo was agreed, examples shown below.
4. The poster designs and text for both the project publicity poster and the forthcoming survey poster were agreed, an example of one is shown below.
5. The A2 informative leaflet that encloses the survey form is agreed to have a front title page and a back illustration when folded down to A5. Opened up, the back will be an A5 size map of Madron Parish with key points illustrated with pictures (Madron village, Chysauster etc). Simon to provide the map and work with Steve on illustrations. The front will have distinct A5 panels holding text and pictures (e.g. what is an NDP, point of survey, endorsement by Col Bolitho etc), and contact links.
6. A trial run of the survey form will be attempted at the Pavilion opening on 19 Oct by Graham. Graham to collect display boards from Peter, Simon to provide Graham with survey drafts and 2 x posters for collection from Mounts Bay reception Friday 18 Oct.
7. Team to work up A5 panel texts from drafts provided by Graham.
8. Simon and Geoffrey agreed that the roll out of the survey to schools would be co-ordinated by them with the school staff as one day exercises.
9. Team still needs to decide on final mailing and collection strategy and the cost implications. Geoffrey will research with Cornwall Council on the option of using their facilities.
10. Next meeting will review the results of the trial survey.

The completed plan must pass an independent examination and gain community support through a referendum of residents.

The plan would then be adopted as a formal planning policy by Cornwall Council. This statutory status gives Neighbourhood Plan's far more weight in planning decisions and can set out local level planning policies for the area, shaping the future development of Madron Parish. There will be events and surveys occurring in the parish from now on so please join in.
