Increasing child and adult activity levels, which will improve health and wellbeing

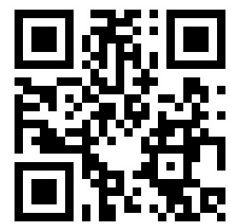


Supporting Cornwall's climate change declaration. This will include lower emissions and tackling congestion
